Have you checked your Portfolio?

On-line viewing of your 2007-2008 financial aid award is available on your Financial Aid Portfolio. The Portfolio is designed to keep you apprised of your financial aid status and enables you to display and print your financial aid awards 24 hours a day! You should periodically check your Tasks to prevent the delay of the disbursement of your financial aid funds.

BILLING STATEMENTS

Statements including Fall 2007 charges were mailed in late June for matriculated, full-time undergraduate and law students with a due date of July 30, 2007. Your promissory note(s) for Perkins, Stafford and/or PLUS Loans must be completed before they can be applied as anticipated aid toward the balance owed on your account. REFUND REQUESTS

If you anticipate a refund from your account, you may request the refund on-line at MySlice.syr.edu or by e-mail at Bursar@syr.edu. You may also make a request in person at 102 Archbold North.

Please keep in mind that an excess of funds must exist on your account for a refund to be processed. You may check your account balance on-line at MySlice.syr.edu.
