



Syracuse University *Scholarship in Action Merit Award Application*

Eligible students must have entered the University without a merit scholarship from Syracuse University; have completed two years of study at SU and achieved junior status during the first semester of the scholarship; have earned an overall grade point average of 3.0; and have demonstrated scholarship in action in their time at SU. A rising junior who applies but does not receive a scholarship may reapply for his or her senior year. While students apply to their home school or college for the scholarship, their academic work in other SU academic units will be taken into consideration in the selection process. In order to maintain their scholarships, students will be required to meet the same academic standards that are required for other SU academic/competitive scholarships.
