Deadline: April 3, 2020

To be eligible to apply for a Scholarship in Action Merit Award, students must have:

- Entered the University without a merit scholarship from Syracuse University
- Completed two years of study at Syracuse University and achieve junior status next fall semester
- Earned an overall grade point average of 3.0 or greater
- Demonstrated Scholarship in Action during their time at Syracuse University

A rising junior who applies but does not receive a scholarship may reapply for his or her senior year. While students apply to their home school or college for the scholarship, their academic work in other academic units will also be taken into consideration in the selection process. Recipients will be required to meet the same academic standards that are required for other University academic and competitive scholarships.
